### Renewal

The Renewal deadline is approaching quickly. You complete your renewal by going to the CRNPEI website and opening the **Member Login**. You must use the email that the system has. The email in the system is the same one where you receive College newsletters. If you are having trouble just give us a call and we will verify the email.

Renewal for 2021-2022 will require you to complete your CCP learning plan from last year at Step 5, see the July newsletter for details at <https://crnpei.ca/wp-content/uploads/2021/07/eNewsletter-July-2021-V6-N7.pdf>

Regular renewal is completed every fall from September 1st to October 1st. Once we reach October 2nd, late renewal begins. If you are renewing during the late renewal period, which is October 2nd to 31st, an additional fee of \$100 is applied to your registration fee.

Any outstanding fees from the past year, such as unpaid account balances, outstanding NSF amounts or late fees must all be paid prior to obtaining a registration renewal.

### Pre-Authorized Debit Program

The **Annual Sign-Up Period** for the Pre-Authorized Debit program is open from **September 1st to October 15th** each year. The PAD program allows a registrant to have automatic withdrawals from their bank account each month to avoid a single payment at the time of renewal.
