### Renewal

The Renewal system will open on September 1st. You complete your renewal by going to the CRNPEI website and opening the **Member Login**. You must use the email that the system has. The email in the system is the same one where you receive College newsletters. If you are having trouble just give us a call and we will verify the email.

Renewal for 2022-2023 will require you to complete your CCP learning plan from last year at Step 5.

Regular renewal is completed every fall from September 1st to 30th. Once we reach October 1st, late renewal begins. If you are renewing during the late renewal period, which is October 1st to 31st, an additional fee of \$100 is applied to your registration fee.

Any outstanding fees from the past year, such as unpaid account balances, outstanding NSF amounts or late fees must all be paid prior to obtaining a registration renewal.

A renewal guide is posted on the main page of our website.



### Pre-Authorized Debit

The **Annual Sign-Up Period** for the Pre-Authorized Debit program is open from **September 1st to October 15th** each year. The PAD program allows a registrant to have automatic withdrawals from their bank account each month to avoid a single payment at the time of renewal. Sign-up requires a one-time only application, and then the registrant can continue in the program without further action unless they wish to withdraw or they have 2 NSF payments in a single year. Debit amounts for the 2022-2023 registration fees are RN \$45.14 per month, NP \$55.97 per month starting November 5, 2021.

### Continuing Competence Program for First Time Registrants in 2021-2022

The Renewal system will open on September 1st as described above. The Continuing Competence Program is an annual requirement for every registrant.

If you are a new registrant to CRNPEI in 2021-2022, you will need to complete a CCP learning plan for 2021-2022 before beginning your renewal.

Access your CCP by going to member login and opening your profile.

You will see the CCP tab on the left, open the tab and begin your 2021-2022 CCP learning plan. You will not be able to begin renewal without a 2021-2022 learning plan.

Once you are in the CCP Program Tab (below) select Create Learning Plan. When completing this plan you are looking back over this past year. Completion and target dates must fall between Nov 1st, 2021 and October 31, 2022.

**We recommend you begin the 2021-2022 plan prior to the renewal period.**
