STRATEGIC OUTCOME 2

Accountable, Quality Professional Practice

Strategic Activities:

CCP – develop an enhanced CCP program to move beyond reflection on Standards to add an annual on-line education module – in topics such as Cultural Awareness, Jurisprudence, Social Media, Antiracism, etc.
Governance Education for Council and Staff
Cultural Awareness Education for Council and Staff

Deliverables

Staff complete Indigenous Canada 12-week Course from UofA –
Practice Directives – current and new topics as required
Adapt and Adopt the BCCNM Indigenous Cultural Safety Standards
Launch an updated CCP in 2024

STRATEGIC OUTCOME 3

Collaboration for Public Protection

Strategic Activities:

Working with government for regulatory amendments and responses to requests for consultation including responding to consultation documents
Collaborating with other regulatory bodies, in nursing and midwifery across disciplines, provincially and federally
Working with Employers related to Risk mitigation – example Substance Use Disorder
